The main reason has been that science cannot be satisfied with metaphors and introspection. In order to gain acceptance, an idea needs to be formulated clearly enough so that it can be used to construct testable hypotheses whose results will clearly support or cast doubt upon the hypothesis. Next, those ideas that are formulable in one or another sort of symbolism or notation are capable of being modeled, and modeling is a huge part of cognitive neuroscience. If an idea cannot be clearly modeled, then there are limits to how widely it can be tested and accepted by a cognitive neuroscience community.
