family in a small, tight knit community in the deep South during the extremely segregated Jim Crow era. He rose to become chair of mechanical engineering at a distinguished university. It is a valuable addition to the canon of biographies, histories, literary works and cultural studies of the South. It captures the mood of Southern writers such as Flannery O'Connor, Pearl Cleage, William Faulkner, Richard Wright and Ralph Ellison. One photo shows him holding a silver salmon, the outcome of one of his favorite hobbies—fishing. In his autobiography, Dr. Thigpen brings the clarity and conciseness of an engineer and research scientist who has written and published numerous articles in refereed journals.
